GOLF CARTS

From time to time we will be refresh everyone on the rules related to your club. Let's refresh everyone on the rules related to Golf Carts.

- 1) Golf carts shall be assigned at the golf pro shop at the time of registration. Players are currently allowed, at the discretion of the Club, to walk and carry their clubs.
- 2) No vehicles other than golf course maintenance vehicles, golf carts, and private golf carts approved by Club shall be permitted on the golf course.
- 3) Club owned golf carts are restricted to use on the golf course and practice areas. No club owned golf carts shall be removed from the Facilities at any time.
- 4) When, in the opinion of the superintendent, the use of Private golf carts will injure the course, said use shall be expressly forbidden (i.e. Aggressive tires).
- 5) Golf carts shall remain on cart paths where directed. Drivers must observe and obey all signs, stakes, roped off areas and other markers used to guide carts. Golf carts shall not be driven or parked within thirty (20) feet of any tee, bunker, green, or hazard except on cart paths. When driving golf carts on fairways, care should be taken to avoid soft areas.
- 6) The club will not assume any property damage or public liability which may result in the use of golf carts.
- 7) Members must be (14) years of age or older to operate a private golf cart unless accompanied by an adult. They must be sixteen (16) years or older to operate a rental cart with a valid driver's license to operate a club owned golf cart.

8) It will be the duty of the Golf Professional to report any non-compliance of private cart guidelines to Management. It will be the duty of the Club Professional to make recommendations to Management in cases of extreme non-compliance concerning private golf cart regulations.

9) Private owned carts will be operated total at the risk and liability of the owner. The Club shall not be held liable for damage or injury sustained as a result of the operation of a private owned golf cart at any time. Private cart owners should properly insure their golf cart for liability. All private golf cart owners shall be required to sign a release of liability, which holds the Club harmless as a result of any loss or damage relating to the owner's operation if the golf cart.

10) Residents with private golf carts may ride with each other but may not loan their golf cart to other golfers.

11) A identification number and yearly decal is to be placed on the cart by the Golf Shop Staff.

12) The right to use a privately owned golf cart on the golf course is currently granted by the Club and is a non-assignable license and personal right. The Club may terminate the license and right at any time.

13) Privately owned golf carts to be used on the golf course must be approved annually by management for appearance and for compliance with other standards as may be determined by the Club.

14) Violation of these golf cart rules may result in immediate suspension of playing privileges and ejection from the golf course.

GOLF CART STORAGE

PCCC does not accept responsibility for fire, theft, or maintenance of the golf cart while stored at PCCC.

Owners will be assigned a storage space for their golf cart and are required to park the cart completely in the space and keep the area neat and orderly.

Gasoline and oil may not be stored in the facility in accordance with fire code regulations.

GOLF CART HANDICAP FLAG

A Handicap Flag on a golf cart signifies that the driver of said cart has a disability that makes walking to their ball a hardship. To qualify for a Handicap Flag the individual must possess a state approved permanent or temporary disabled parking placard/license plate in their name or be approved by the management.

Handicap members must keep carts a minimum of 10 yards from the green and keep off the mowed approaches.

They start teeing off at 8:00am Tuesday mornings. Meet in the golf shop at 7:45. Beat the heat and we're finished by noon! Don't forget the Wednesday night group meets at 5:30pm.

SWIMMING POOL

The pool will be restricted to 50% capacity, allowing us to have 60 members and guests inside of the gates at any given time. So please note once we hit that capacity on any date, we will be forced to do a one-in and one-out entry.

Please note that swimmers always swim at their own risk at the PCCC. All persons using the pool or pool area shall assume all responsibility for their own safety and shall be deemed to have assumed the risk of using the pool or pool area and agree by their presence in the pool area that neither the Club or employees shall be held liable for any loss, injury or death arising out of the pool or pool area.

- 1) Children the age of twelve (12) and under and all minors who are unable to swim are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by a parent or other person sixteen (16) years of age or older who knows how to swim and agrees to assume responsibility for the child's safety and behavior.
- 2) All children without adequate swimming ability must be accompanied in the water, by a parent or adult guardian at all times
- 3) Pool attendants shall have full authority to maintain order, reprimand, discipline, restrict and evict any individual not complying with the rules and regulations.
- 4) Running, wrestling, pushing, dunking and excessive noise or other hazardous activity will not be permitted in the pool or pool area.
- 5) No glass containers of any kind will be permitted within the pool area.
- 6) Lifesaving and pool cleaning equipment should be used only for the purpose intended.
- 7) Please do not unnecessarily talk to or distract the pool attendant(s) if on duty.
- 8) Swimmers are not allowed in any part of the Clubhouse in their swim attire. Swimmers must be dry and wear a cover-up or must be fully clothed when entering the Clubhouse.
- 9) Members and their guests are responsible for properly disposing of their trash.
- 10) No person shall enter pool area at any unauthorized time.

Illness and/or Medical Conditions:

- 1) Persons are not permitted in the pool if they have a cold, cough, fever, infection of any kind, skin rash, inflamed eye(s).
- 2) Persons with physical or neurological disabilities must always be accompanied by adult guardian in the pool area.

Guest Pool Privileges:

Members may bring guests to the pool, providing the members sign their guests in for a \$5.00 daily pool fee charge to their account. Grandchild visiting a member, shall be waived the guest fee. Babysitters for children shall not be considered guests when present in lieu of a parent and will not be subject to guest fees. Guests need to be accompanied by the sponsoring Member when using the pool facilities. Guest privileges may be limited as determined at the sole discretion of the Club.

Food and/or Drink:

All food and drink must be purchased from the Club except when both are closed. No outside Alcohol beverage can be brought onto the Club property at any time.

Kiddie Pool:

For use by children 6 years of age or younger and requires direct supervision. There is NO lifeguard supervision at any time. Parents/grandparents and/or guest are responsible for their children's safety and must always accompany them at all time.

Monday – Closed (except Labor Day)

Tuesday - Saturday 10:00 am to 12:00 pm – Adult Swim
12:00 pm to 7:00 pm – Open Swim

Sunday 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm – Open Swim

A lifeguard may not be on duty during pool hours

The camp will be available for Ponca City Members (Full, Nonresident & Social) and open to the public. All different types of golfers from beginners to advance are invited to participate in this NEW, fun and exciting summer golf program.

THE CONCEPT & FUNCTION OF OUR PROGRAM

The primary goal for the Ponca City Junior Golf Program is to have fun while teaching/developing life-long golfers. Our program will be offering instruction, activities, details on the history of golf, and observance of rules and etiquette. This program ensures that all participants are taught golf in a manner that promotes enjoyment, while at the same time hitting home the essential link between golf and interpersonal skills. Being able to allow junior golfers play golf to the best of their ability and to contribute to the personal growth of each junior by positive social and character values is our top instruction priority.

METHODS OF INSTRUCTION

The most important aspect of the PCCC Junior Program is to enable each one of our students to achieve his/her personal best in golf through our five primary instructional area:

1. Rules of Golf
2. Swing Fundamentals
3. Course Management
4. Personal Confidence and Overall Advancement
5. Enjoyment of the Game.

The PCCC Junior Program will be open to all boys and girls, Ages 4-18 years of age as of June 16th, 2020. Participants will be grouped by age 8 and under & 8 and up.
